[Instruction of Reading Report]

For the quiz requirement, you have to submit three reading reports for the first three monthly classes. Each reading report consists of two parts - a) <u>Summary of on-line</u> <u>lectures</u> b) <u>Summary of outside reading passage</u>.

a) Summary of on-line lectures

From all broadcasting lectures of each monthly class, you have to select 4 lectures and make a summary report. Each report contains: 1) List <u>4-5</u> vocabulary with their English definitions along with example sentences, 2) Quote 2 grammar points Mr. Tsai orally instructed in the on-line broadcasting lecture, or 3) Your reflection (Option! If you do this part, you will earn extra points of the score)

b) Summary of outside reading passage

From any educational resources, you have to obtain 1 short English passage whose topic and readability level are equivalent to the ones of textbook chapters. Every passage you intend has 4 paragraphs, at least (no more than 7 paragraphs). After your reading, make a summary for each of them, you address "Main Point" for each paragraph. #Use A-4 sized paper for your work. And staple all the paper with a cover page indicating 1. the running number of report, 2. your student ID, 3. your name. (You have to attach a copy of original passage in your reading report)

[Reminders]

- 1. You are obligated to watch and listen to all the broadcasting lectures and do the exercise of each textbook chapter before each monthly class meeting.
- 2. For monthly classes, do NOT sign in for your classmates who are absent from the class, which is <u>a cheating behavior</u> and regarded as <u>a serious violation to OUK's class</u> regulations. You will be fully responsible for your doing.
- 3. Excessive class absence may considerably affect your semester grade.
- 4. Skipping any quiz or exam will greatly jeopardize your semester grade.
